5 **PROPERTY DISPUTE-FORMER CN RIGHT-OF-WAY-GLEN ROAD**

Clerk advised Council that Mr. Kennedy asked her to clarify a statement made by Councillor Mark Foreman indicating that the Snowmobile Association might possibly use the Walking Trail in the winter if it was extended. Councillor M. Foreman stated that the proposal was made to the Village that if the trail was extended, would they be able to use it in the winter, but the issue was never taken any further, as no one had ever contacted him regarding same since that time.
