PURPOSE OF MEETING - WALKING TRAIL



To advise the adjacent landowners of the plans of the Village to extend the Walking Trail that is now already in operation, and to also advise them that the Right-Of-Way belongs to the Village of Stanley by way of a Quit-Claim Deed from the Federal Government, dated January 1987.

Paul Levesque, Solicitor, explained this situation to Mr. Kennedy, but he was not very agreeable to the information received or the plans to extend the trail, as it would come within 50 feet of the rear of his house. Village Council advised him that they would accommodate him by any means possible, and would certainly make it a point so that the trail would not interfere with their privacy.

He left the meeting, stating that he would be back to us, after he has spoken with his lawyer.
