Topics discussed were as follows:



–Heritage Buildings at Stanley Fair Grounds – whether or not they are planning to rebuild, etc., and the possibility of getting federal funding assistance;

–Policing in Stanley area – Mayor Foreman advised Mr. Savoie that we have not been happy with the service and coverage that we have been receiving, and that a rumor has surfaced that the Stanley Office will be closed soon. Mr. Savoie promised to speak with the Solicitor General's office concerning this problem, and will await our letter to him following a meeting that Council has planned with Mr. John Coleman, District Commander. Council will send a letter to Mr. Savoie indicating the priority issues and stressing how much we do not want to lose our office to Keswick;

–Clerk reported that Michael Filato from CIBC, Montreal has not been very responsive to her calls concerning the Village's acquisition of the present CIBC building, and asked if Mr. Savoie could speed up the process in any way. Mr. Savoie stated that he would contact CIBC at once.
