**SPECIAL MEETING OF STANLEY VILLAGE COUNCIL**  
**JANUARY 8, 2002**  
**EMERGENCY MEASURES ORGANIZATION**

Council met with Randy Robertson of EMO concerning the Mock Disaster which is scheduled for May 28, 2002 in Stanley.

Mr. Robertson advised Village Council that there is funding available to assist in preparation for an Emergency situation, and advised Clerk that the application would be required to be submitted by Wednesday, January 16, 2002. He advised her to list the expenses, with a breakdown of each, and submit it by fax (453-5513) either to him or Art Scaling by January 16<sup>th</sup>, 2002.

Mr. Robertson also advised us that we need to compose a new Disaster Plan, as the one we have has expired. He stated that we should request a copy of the contract from Red Cross and to ask for an audit; also, to obtain a copy of the School's plan. He suggested that our Co-Ordinator should really be a person involved in the administration of the Village affairs. Council agreed that the Clerk could be the Co-Ordinator but not to be expected to take time out of the office for training, etc., as Councillor Ross Walker agreed to assist her by attending any courses, etc.

Mr. Robertson advised the four (4) phases of an Emergency Situation, those being: Alert, Impact, Response and Recovery. He also mentioned the three (3) C's involved which are: - Command, Control, and Communications.

Plans will be made by Stanley Village Council to compose a new plan as early in the New Year as possible.
