RE: NB DAY ACTIVITIES - 2005

Mr. Marquis opened the meeting by distributing a copy of the Logo (CELEBRATE!) For 2005. He also circulated information regarding drawing and colouring contests for the children, and stated that they hoped to have it out to the schools sometime within a week or so. He advised that the theme for 2005 NB Day is '**KEEP MOVIN!**'. He reported that our budget has not moved yet and has not been approved.

Councillor R. Walker advised Mr. Marquis of Council's progress in obtaining entertainment and other items concerning NB Day. He reported that we wish to have an Honour Guard; that RCMP will assist wherever we need them; hope to have a few volunteers to assist with parking; planning to hold a Duck Race; planning to have agenda for the day printed on a pamphlet or a handout on corrugated plastic; and he reported on most of the entertainment in the Park and the Dance Hall that has been explored but not completely confirmed as yet.

Mr. Marquis stated that he thought that we were certainly well on our way, and plans were set to hold our next meeting on JUNE 6, 2005 AT 5:00 pm.

Following Mr. Marquis' departure from the meeting, Council discussed the following:
Parking - Lower part of School Parking Lot; Tennis Courts at the School; Behind the Post Office; Johnstone's Pharmacy; Behind the Dance Hall; In the Field; St. Patrick's Roman Catholic Church Parking Lot.

Signage - B. MacDonald spoke with Bill Leonard who advised to wait to see what happens with legislation which should happen in the next week or so.

Tenders are to be received on or before 3:00 on Thursday, April 28th, 2005, and Council advised Clerk to open them and give them to Sara Dunton for review over the week-end. Council will meet (prior to a photo appointment at 6:00 PM at Nashwaak Villa) briefly on Monday, May 2nd at 5:00 PM to make a decision as to what they are going to do and when they will award the tenders. Clerk was instructed to advise contractors that they will be advised by Thursday, May 5th, 2005 of the results.

LIGHTS - WALKING TRAIL

B. MacDonald advised Council that she called Liteco and they quoted a price of \$975. Per light for Walking Trail (not including Posts).

PARKING LOT - AGRENA

R. Walker requested that Mayor Foreman contact DOT to repair the pot holes, etc. in the parking lot at the Agrena prior to August 1, 2005.
