

**SPECIAL MEETING OF STANLEY VILLAGE COUNCIL
TUESDAY NIGHT, MARCH 3, 2009

--Policing Committee Meeting – clerk was requested to respond to their email and advise that both Barb MacDonald and Richard Storey will be attending;


--MacGillivray 50th Anniversary – clerk will respond and advise that someone from the Village will be attending the celebration and will present a certificate on August 15, 2009;
