Discussion Topic:

Fire Department boundaries

Mr. Kavanaugh's office has measured the boundaries for the SVFD and indicated to Council on a map the boundary lines. Fire Department members discussed certain roads and their halfway points and their concerns with regards to access i.e. Tay Falls Road, School House Road.

Mr. Kavanaugh advised that the ½ way point from Stanley to Juniper is Deersdale. He will be leaving the revenue as is for this area but will have Juniper respond to that point from that direction and likewise Stanley will respond to that point from this direction. Due to the closure of the Nashwaak West Road, Stanley will respond to this side of that road, the Armstrong Road, and out to the post office at Route 8.

Mr. Kavanaugh also advised that in 2007 and 2008 Stanley had 10% coverage area of Douglas. In 2009 and 2010 that increased to 25%. With the new area considered (St. Mary's) it will be a benefit of approximately 5% or a ball park increase of between \$5,000.00 to \$8,000.00.

Council, SVFD and Mr. Kavanaugh agreed to the coverage area as outlined on the map brought by Mr. Kavanaugh. He indicated he would provide Council with a copy of same.

Council also discussed with guests the purchase of a new fire truck. It was suggested that Council apply to the borrowing board soon for the purchase of a new truck and approach the Department of Supply and Services to see when they will be doing their tendering as they will have 13-14 trucks coming up to tender and Stanley should “piggy-back” on their tender.

B. MacDonald moved the meeting adjourned at 8:00 p.m..
