10 **YOUR HEALTH – YOUR HEART WALK/RUN-ATHON**

This will be held on Sunday, May 30<sup>th</sup>, 2010 rain or shine. S. D. Bartlett reported that she would have registration, etc. set up at the Presbyterian Church at the top of Stanley Hill and it will serve as a base. Also, there will be pit-stops set up where water, juice, etc. will be available. The location for the walk/run-athon will be the Red Rock Road as there is not much traffic on the road, etc. and it would be much safer than other busier roads. S. D. Bartlett had advised that she had heard that Mary Hay and some others were planning a walkathon the same week-end with funds to be donated to The Terry Fox Centre, but they agreed that we could carry on with our plans for May 30<sup>th</sup>. Thus far, \$8,636. has been raised by Stanley. It was agreed by Council that we offer a Family Rate of \$30 for parents and children. Plans are to ask businesses to donate some refreshments. Prizes will be from our promotional items. T. Hunter and S. D. Bartlett will prepare signs.

Bay (Heated)	\$300 + Utilities
Bay (Unheated)	\$200 + Utilities
Glen Road	\$450 (Includes Utilities (Upstairs and/or Downstairs))

Council agreed that if they were interested in the downstairs at Glen Road that Council would give the space to them for 6 months at \$300/month, including heat and lights) as we have done this in the past with some new businesses in the community. Barb MacDonald will contact him to advise of the space and the prices. Upper Nashwaak Outreach have advised that the light in the back of the office is out and that only one light is on in the boardroom. Clerk will contact Andrew Carr to check this out and also to check out why their electricity costs seem to be so high.

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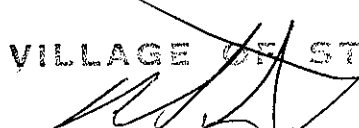
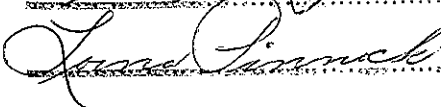
