Zoning for Nashwaak Villa

Correspondence was received from Bonnie MacNeil dated June 10th, 2010 advising the location for the new facility is the Holt/Pinnock/DOT property on the Limekiln Road. She, on behalf of the Villa Board is requesting a re-zoning, if necessary to allow for the construction of this building in this area.



Council reviewed the zoning map in accordance with the PID numbers provided by Ms. MacNeil and came to the conclusion the area in question is zoned residential. B. MacDonald recalls discussions during past

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council meetings wherein it was suggested zoning for the general village area is or could be deemed Residential / Commercial. S. D. Bartlett contacted former Mayor Mark Foreman who indicated that to the best of his knowledge this is the case.

After a review of the Zoning By-laws and Municipal Plan, Council feels it is probable the area for the new facility will have to be re-zoned to Institutional. S. D. Bartlett will make further inquiries and wait for an e-mail from Mr. B. Hoganson at Local Government to provide information concerning the process to amend a by-law. Council will meet again next week to discuss further.
