SVFD Member interviews

Council met with two members of the SVFD regarding the future of the Department and the direction it is going, as well as their thoughts regarding Fire Chief.

Nashwaak Curling Club

MLA Kirk MacDonald advised that he has been approached by the Nashwaak Curling Club requesting assistance for funding for a new roof (approx. cost \$20,000). A meeting will be held at a later date to discuss this project.

Shale Gas; Municipal Boundaries

Mr. MacDonald advised Council that presently there is a growing interest by the surrounding communities to merge and become part of the Village of Stanley. The main reason for this is that there is great opposition to Shale Gas exploration/fracking in the area. This activity is not permitted within municipal boundaries. Mr. MacDonald suggested to Council that if they were interested in expanding their boundaries the first step would be to request a feasibility study be initiated. The areas to be included in the study would include the LSD's of Stanley, St. Mary's and Douglas inside.

Council agreed to contact the Minister of Local Government, Hon. Bruce Fitch, to begin the process of a feasibility study to explore expanding the limits of the Village of Stanley.


