Update on the Sisson Mine Project.

Deirdre Riley provided members of Council with an update on the progress with the Sisson Mine project. She indicated they are relatively on track and that a "Terms of Reference" is being drafted at this time, along with a "Project Description" which will encompass all aspects of the project.

HDI is considering opening a "Store Front" in the Stanley area which will be a place where residents can drop in and discuss and research the work being done if desired. She is hopeful they will be able to hire a Local Communications/Relations Manager to be at the Store Front on a part time basis.

Plans are being made to have an open house sometime in April wherein booths with all HDI's "Technical People" will be present to answer questions and concerns. HDI is also considering approaching the high school and environmental groups to do site tours when exploration begins again in the spring.

Ms. Riley will be in the area again for one week in March and then for the majority of the month of April. She will contact Council again at that time to again bring them up to date.

The meeting adjourned at 11:15 with Ms. Riley accompanying Councillors to view 80 Irishtown Road for a possible Store Front location.
