Meeting to discuss SVFD Fire Chief / Lift Stations & ROW / Park Repairs / Dog Licensing

Correspondence from Joanne Colford, dated July 2nd, 2011 received July 4th, 2011 thanking Council for offering the position of Fire Chief but declining due to circumstances beyond her control.

Council discussed their options with respect to whether or not the interview process should begin again, or to appoint the other applicant, Keith Lyons as chief. It was decided to ask Kenny Colford to stay on as interim Fire Chief for a 90 day period or until Council had an opportunity to speak the SVFD Officer Committee, if one was appointed, as per the SVFD Policy Guidelines No. 3.1.

Council also discussed an e-mail received from G. Spencer who feels, due to the issue with the ROW for lift station #2 and delays in getting the tender out, it may be too late in the season to continue with the plans to replace the lift stations this year and suggests it wait until Spring 2012. Council agreed to delay the project until then, and to advise the Borrowing Board we do not need the funding for same at this time. Council would also like G. Spencer to provide them with a diagram of the area needed for lift station #2 so that they can approach David & Susan Currie about the purchase of a piece of their property. B. MacDonald advised that she spoke with the Currie's about the Village acquiring this land and was told they would sell for \$15,000. Council feels this figure is excessive and will forward correspondence to the Currie's asking them to reconsider.


A quote to repair the gazebos, benches, picnic tables, etc. at the park was received from Brandon Mitchell, a carpentry student at NBCC Moncton. A

price of \$446.55 was given to repair the items listed above, labour and materials. Council felt this was fair and reasonable.


