Meeting to discuss: Snow Removal Tender 2011-2012

Council invited R. Foreman in to discuss his snow removal bid submitted October 31st, 2011. That bid was \$25,000 plus HST.

Council opened discussions with R. Foreman by advising his bid was one of two received and that the other bid was successful, however, the contractor was not able to fulfill the obligation. Council asked R. Foreman if he would consider adjusting his bid, indicating they felt price submitted is high for the scope of work required and the allotted budget. R. Foreman advised when he submitted the bid his equipment was broken down and he was not certain he would be able to repair it. Since then his equipment has been repaired, and he advised he would be willing to do the snow removal for \$15,000 plus HST.

R. Foreman did have some concerns about the removal of snow in front of Steven MacKay's house, and would like to have reflectors placed around the park fence and along the driveway at 80 Irishtown Road. Council thanked Mr. Foreman for attending and will advise of their decision.

Council agreed to the revised bid of \$15,000 plus HST. Council will also address the issues raised by R. Foreman.


