Special Meeting to discuss Nashwaak Room Restoration and Timeline for Project

Council discussed with members of the Agrena Board the projected cost of the project, \$28,000. The Board would like to have renovations completed by October 2013. They have discussed having volunteer labour, summer students or parents from Minor Hockey involved in the process, but feel it would be better to have Council handle the project and hire a contractor. Council agreed with that decision and will tender the project by September 20th.

It was suggested perhaps the project could be done in two phases, demo in the fall of 2012 and completion in the spring of 2013. T. Koch will be consulted to write the tender.
