Representatives presented an update with respect to the Sisson Mine Project. The Feasibility Study & Environmental Impact Assessment should be complete by the third quarter of 2012. Once the draft EIA is provided to the Province they have one year to conduct the public consultation process, potentially pushing that phase into 2013. After that, if the EIA is acceptable, permit applications will have to be completed. Updates are available on their website. HDI is also working with the Nashwaak Watershed Association regarding Habitat Replacement and Enhancement.
