***Special Meeting to discuss the Regionalization transition process & how it relates to
the Rural Planning District Commission***

Mr. McAlinden presented to explain some of the services will be offering to
municipalities once the Regionalization takes effect in January 2013.

Presently the Commission offers services in four areas (not to municipalities);
Development, Planners, GIS & Mapping Services, and Control Services. They also have
the capability to assist with Municipal Plans.

In January 2013 these services will be available to municipalities in this region as well.
The choice to use these services will be with each municipality. It is not mandatory.
Municipalities currently using the services of Commissions in different districts cannot
opt out of the contract for a three year period.

New provincial building codes coming into effect January 2013. They will be offering
training courses to building inspectors.

Presently they are looking at several options to offer services, i.e. retainers; flat fees per
service; dog control; sewage services. A more firm list of services and fees will be
available by September.

Council thanked Mr. McAlinden for attending.

Manhole/Sewage Drain Repairs

Councillor Pinnock suggested the work for the repairs to the manholes be tendered rather
than be included as part of the maintenance contract. Council agreed. Mayor Foreman
and J. Pinnock will scope out the work.
