Special Meeting & Presentation regarding Waste & Wastewater Management & Closure Plan for the Sisson Mine

Presenter Dan Friedman with Knight Piesold Consulting in BC has been contracted by HDI to devise a Waste & Wastewater Management and Closure Plan for the Sission Mine.

The guiding principles of the plan are the protection of water sources, geotechnical stability, to make the project economically viable, limit the footprint and visual impact of the project and generate a design for closure.

Definitions of technical terms, types of rock, and a review of the design and layout were presented.

It is estimated the mine will produce 30,000 tons per day and have a mine life of 32 years. The closure goal is to return the site to pre-mining levels of use and productivity, safely manage the water and wastewater, and have a progressive reclamation.

Council will be provided a copy of Mr. Friedman's presentation.
