***Special Meeting at Stanley High School regarding the Reciprocal Agreement between District 18 and the Village of Stanley***

The meeting was held to discuss the proposed Reciprocal Agreement between District 18 and the Village of Stanley; as well as the proposed agreement between the working group now designated as UNCLE (Upper Nashwaak Community Liaison Effort) and the Village of Stanley.

Tom Cameron advised that he, staff and custodians are in favor of the agreement, however, due to changes at the District level he was not certain how quickly it could be reviewed and put in place.

Jody Pinnock advised that the working group has now come up with a temporary name, UNCLE (Upper Nashwaak Community Liaison Effort) and he is Chair of the committee. UNCLE presented letters of support from groups that are currently using the facility after hours; SYNC and Sr. Men's Basketball. J. Pinnock advised the group is still working on policy and details for scheduling, keys, janitorial services etc. and hope to have that completed by mid September.

MLA Kirk MacDonald encouraged the group to make use of available provincial and federal funding programs and that he would offer support where needed.

Mayor Foreman advised members of UNCLE that as quickly as they have compiled the information Council requested, they will be in a position to sign the agreement with them and District 18.
