**Special Meeting to discuss:**

**Community Restructuring**

Council welcomed Ivan Corbett, LSD Manager and Johnny St-Onge of DELG to the meeting to discuss the process of community restructuring.

Council asked about the requirements for a Rural Community. Mr. St-Onge advised that the populations must be at least 3000, with a tax base of \$200 million.

Council advised that they were interested in expanding the community boundaries to include those areas in the school catchment area.

Mr. St-Onge will research what those population and tax base number would be, and bring the information back to Council.

**English Settlement Road**

Council read a letter from DTI advising that they would be completing the English Settlement Road chipseal project this year.

**Sewage – Environmental Trust Fund**

Council read a letter from DELG advising that the Village is being awarded \$10,000 from the Environmental Trust Fund. This funding will be used to study and improve the sewage infrastructure.


**Anglophone West School District Reciprocal Agreement Renewal**
