

BYLAW NO. A-2

**A BYLAW RESPECTING THE COMPOSITION AND REMUNERATION
FOR MAYOR AND COUNCILLORS**

BE IT ENACTED by the Council of the Village of Stanley as follows:

1. Composition of Council

1.01 The members of the elected Council of the Village of Stanley shall consist of one Mayor and three Councillors who shall be nominated and elected at large.

1.02 The elected Council of the Village of Stanley shall elect a Deputy Mayor.

1.03 The Council of the Village of Stanley shall remain in office until all vacancies for office on the Council have been filled in accordance with the provisions of the *Municipal Elections Act*.

1.04 All qualified voters resident in the Village of Stanley shall be entitled to vote for candidates for the office of Mayor and for the office of Councillor.

2. Remuneration of Council

2.01 For attendance at regular meetings of Council, the Mayor shall be paid a salary of \$120.00 per meeting, and for attendance at special meetings of Council, the Mayor shall be paid a salary of \$50.00 per meeting. The remuneration shall be paid in quarterly installments.

2.02 For attendance at regular meetings of Council, the Deputy Mayor and each Councillor shall be paid a salary of \$80.00 per meeting, and for attendance at special meetings of Council, the Deputy Mayor and each Councillor shall be paid a salary of \$50.00 per meeting. The remuneration shall be paid in quarterly installments.


2.03 When the Mayor, Deputy Mayor, or any Councillor is absent from a regular meeting of the Council, the Village Treasurer shall deduct the sum of \$10.00 from the salary of each absentee unless such absentee is excused for reasonable cause by resolution of the Council.

3. Repeal Provision

3.01 Bylaw No. 6, A Bylaw Regarding Number Of Councillors On Village Council, passed by Village Council on January 18, 1971, is hereby repealed.

3.02 The repeal of Bylaw No. 6, A Bylaw Regarding Number Of Councillors On Village Council, shall not affect any penalty, forfeiture or liability, incurred before such repeal or any proceeding for enforcing the same completed or pending at the time of repeal; nor shall it repeal, defeat, disturb, invalidate, or prejudicially affect any matter or thing whatsoever completed, existing or pending at the time of repeal.
