

BYLAW NO. A-5

A BY-LAW TO ESTABLISH A PLANNING ADVISORY COMMITTEE

BE IT ENACTED by the Council of the Village of Stanley as follows:

1. Establishment

1.01 Pursuant to the provisions of the *Community Planning Act*, being Chapter C-12, RSNB, 1973, a Planning Advisory Committee may be established for the Village of Stanley.

1.02 Subject to the provisions of this bylaw, persons appointed to the Planning Advisory Committee may be members of the Council or servants of the municipality but the majority shall be other than such members and servants.

1.03 The Planning Advisory Committee may make rules for the conduct of its business and may, from time to time, amend the rules so long as the provisions therein do not conflict with the *Community Planning Act*, the *Municipalities Act*, the *Stanley Village Charter* or the *Bylaws* of the Village of Stanley.

2. Appointments

2.01 To be a member of the Planning Advisory Committee a person shall be,

- (a) eligible to vote under the *Municipalities Act*, and
- (b) a resident in the municipality.

2.02 Persons appointed to the Planning Advisory Committee may be members of the Council or servants of the municipality but the majority shall be other than such members and servants.

2.03 Terms of appointments for members serving on the Planning Advisory Committee shall be in accordance with the requirements of the *Community Planning Act*.

3. Expenses

The Council shall pay such expenses of the Planning Advisory Committee as are approved by the Council.

4. REPEAL PROVISION


4.01 Bylaw No. 11, A Bylaw To Establish A Planning Advisory Committee, passed by Village Council on September 13, 1973, is hereby repealed.

4.02 The repeal of Bylaw No. 11, A Bylaw To Establish A Planning Advisory Committee, shall not affect any penalty, forfeiture or liability, incurred before such repeal or any proceeding for enforcing the same completed or pending at the time of repeal; nor shall it repeal, defeat, disturb, invalidate or prejudicially affect any matter or thing whatsoever completed, existing or pending at the time of repeal.
