

BY-LAW NO. S-1

A BY-LAW RESPECTING LOITERING, BEGGING, AND SOLICITING

Whereas sections 91.1 and 91.2 of the *Municipalities Act*, and amendments thereto, states as follows:

- 91.1(1) No person shall loiter unless such person, when required to do so, justifies his reason for doing so.
- 91.1(2) No person shall beg or solicit from door to door or in a public place except as may be authorized by the municipality.
- 91.1(3) A person who violates this section commits an offence punishable under Part II of the *Provincial Offences Procedure Act* as a category B offence.
- 91.2 Section 91.1 shall be in force in every municipality that by by-law adopts that section as being in force in that municipality and every municipality has authority to make such by-law.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ENACTED by the Council of the Village of Stanley as follows:

1. Adoption

Section 91.1 of the *Municipalities Act* is hereby adopted as being in force in the Village of Stanley.

2. Repeal Provision

2.01 By-law No. 24, A Bylaw Of The Village of Stanley Respecting Loitering, Begging, And Soliciting, passed by Village Council on October 24, 1985, is hereby repealed.

2.02 The repeal of By-law No. 24, A Bylaw Of The Village of Stanley Respecting Loitering, Begging, And Soliciting, shall not affect any penalty, forfeiture or liability, incurred before such repeal or any proceeding for enforcing the same completed or pending at the time of repeal; nor shall it repeal, defeat, disturb, invalidate or

prejudicially affect any matter or thing whatsoever completed, existing or pending at the time of repeal.
