

Thursday, August 14, 1980.

The regular monthly meeting was held in the Council Chamber with Mayor John Mac Gillway presiding.

The meeting opened with a prayer for civic authorities.

The minutes were read & approved on a motion by Councillor Sansom seconded by Councillor Buttiny.

After a short discussion Council asked the clerk to get rates for more liability insurance for the Village.

Councillor Buttiny told the Council that it was known by the Recreation Council that he was to represent the Village at their meetings, but he had yet to attend one.

There followed a discussion about roads and Mayor Mac Gillway told Council that he had received word from the Department of Transportation that \$22000 was to be allotted to the Village for roadwork. Council discussed ~~their~~ their responsibilities for roadwork. It was moved by Councillor Sansom and seconded by Councillor Buttiny that "The Village hire a man for the job of cleaning out storm sewers at a reasonable rate per hour" earned.

Council decided not to have a final meeting with Kendall and Associates until the following matters had been attended to by Rufford Construction ① The lagoon ② Eva Rogers ③ Sidewalks ④ all leases ⑤ C. N. R. right of way. Accounts were discussed. It was moved

for the year September 1980 to September 1981. " Council.

In response to Council's contact with Central Trust regarding the More building as an Unseptic Schemes, the porch was torn off and parts of the building have been boarded up.

Council discussed and approved a list of user fees for small businesses in the Village.

Meeting adjourned on a motion from Councillor Sansom.
