

Thursday, December 11, 1980

The regular monthly meeting of the Stanley Village Council was held in the Council Chamber with Mayor John Mac Gillway presiding.

The meeting opened with a prayer for Civic Authorities.

Minutes were read & approved on a motion from Councillor Mac Naughton seconded by Councillor Briting.

Mayor Mac Gillway had been talking to a lady about the Community Development Project and was told that money could be used for cleaning up cut down trees. He is now trying to coordinate the N.B.C. & C. and the Telephone Co. to see if he can get them to cut the trees.

The oil tank at the work has been replaced for \$75 fifty dollars of which was covered by the Insurance.

Sewage bill has been adjusted for the School Board.

Council decided to leave the grant for the library as it was even though their request of November 27 had been misunderstood.

Councillor Briting had been to the last Recreation Committee meeting and presented Council with a proposed financial plan to have a Recreation Director for this year. Council took the plan home for study and will hold a special meeting regarding it on December 16.

James Kennedy made a request for a number of items for 1981, including a raise in salary.
