

Thursday, July 10, 1950.

The regular monthly meeting of the Stanley Village Council was held in the Council Chambers at 7.30 p.m. Mayor John Mac Gillivray presided.

The meeting opened with a prayer for Civic Authorities.

The minutes were read, corrected & approved on a motion from Councillor Britton.

Business from the minutes included a lengthy discussion about the Stanley Recreation Council. Councillor Britton is now Village Council representative to the Recreation Council. Village Council decided that the Recreation Council must make sure that they have a lease from the Agricultural Society for Head House. Before Village Council will do anything about sewage hook up or utility bills.

Road Repairs for the Village were discussed. Mayor Mac Gillivray had been talking to the District Engineer & he & Councillor Sanson had been talking to members of the D. O. T. and the possibility of road repairs now seems more favorable.

Recreation Council requested that the ditch on the school property be cleaned. Council decided that since it was not Village property it was not the responsibility of Council.

Councillors Mac Naughton and Sanson are going to present Council with an estimated cost for clean-up of ditches, gutches etc. in the Village. They will include certain suggestions made by Councillor Britton in order to improve the look of the park.

It was reported that the Committee

It was moved by Councillor ~~Shelley~~ ^{Sanson} & seconded by Councillor Brittany that the Sewage User Fee be \$160 ^{USER} ~~per~~ ^{year}. Individuals should be billed quarterly and businesses and institutions should be billed yearly. Motion Carried.

Deputy Chaffey has become an agent for Imperial Oil, replacing Mr. Mashey. Clerk was asked to send a letter to Mr. Chaffey regarding care & cleaning of furnaces. (page 5).

Councillor Mac Naughton mentioned the dead elm trees in the Village but the problem was tabled.
