

Thursday, September 11, 1980

The regular monthly meeting of the Stanley Village Council took place in the Council Chambers with Mayor John Mac Gillivray presiding.

The meeting opened with a prayer for Local Authorities

Minutes were read and adopted on a motion from Councillor ~~Sims~~^{Mac Naughton}, seconded by Councillor Sansom.

Mayor Mac Gillivray reported that he had been told by a representative of the Department of Transportation that instead of spending the (\$20,000) twenty-thousand dollars on Stanley roads this year, (\$200,000) two hundred thousand will be spent on Stanley Hill in 1981. Council agreed that they should keep in close touch with the Department of Transportation and the Honorable David Bishop when the 1981 budget is being made up.

It was brought to Council attention that a ditch by property owned by Harriet Hossack's property needs to be filled in. Culverts requested by various citizens were also discussed. Council was informed that Pat Flynn had given an estimate on culverts, but that Douglas Mac Donald had not, as yet. It was moved by Councillor Sansom and seconded by Councillor Mac Naughton that the lowest bidder be given the job of Mrs. Hossack's ditch and that culverts be replaced or put in for Harry Mac Aloon, Eddie Bubar and ⁽¹⁾ ⁽²⁾ ⁽³⁾ Kyle Douglass.
