

Thursday, June 12, 1980.

A special meeting of the Stanley Village Council was held in the Council Chambers at which Bob Robins was present to discuss the wrap up of Sewage matter. He brought with him a user's list which was partially discussed.

Since, in order to decide user's rates, it was necessary to have a salary figure for Mr. Kennedy and the Village Clerk a meeting was called by Mayor Max Sullivan.

Meeting was opened with a prayer for Kiwi Authorities. Since it was a special meeting minutes for June 12 were not read.

It was moved by Councillor Sansom and seconded by Councillor Buttery that Mr. Kennedy be given \$1800/annum retroactive to January, 1980. Carried.

Councillor Sansom and the clerk left the room while clerk's salary was discussed.

It was moved by Councillor Buttery and seconded by Councillor Max Throughton that 1600/annum starting in July, 1980 be paid to the clerk for sewage administration with the understanding that at the end of a 3 mt. period this be reviewed. Carried.

Councillor Sansom volunteered to go to Fredericton tomorrow to investigate why the Department of Transportation did not follow Council's list of priorities for road work in 1980.

Councillor Buttery moved the meeting be adjourned.
