

Friday, March 30, 1981

Regular monthly meeting of the Stoney Village Council was held in the Council Chamber with Mayor John Mac Gillivray in the chair.

The meeting opened with a prayer for Civic Authorities.

The minutes were read, corrected & adopted on a motion by Councillor Mac Naughton seconded by Councillor Senoon.

Mayor Mac Gillivray reported on a meeting about Industrial Relations that he attended recently as the representative of the Capital Regional Development Association.

A letter was read from the <sup>Chicago</sup> Upper Deshewash Recreation Council requesting that Council send a letter to Mr. Kennedy & Mr. Durand of the Department of Youth, Recreation and Culture stating Village Council's financial position regarding a Recreation Office in this area. Clerk was asked to write to them and to inquire if they have met with members of the Municipal Service area and if so, what their reaction was.

Clerk had received <sup>several</sup> letters for sewage collection from Mrs. O'Keefe, Mac Adam Village Club. These were read and received and Clerk was advised to include a copy of the first, where needed, in the next issue.

A letter to Arnold Murphy regarding sewage hook-ups for the farmyards was read. Clerk was asked to write to the Lullin Health Inspection Branch to see if they would write similar letters to others who have not hooked up. Clerk was also asked to contact Welfare to see if any houses that have the benefits of Sewage hook-up, are owned by that Department.
