There was a special meeting of the Stanley Village Council held in the Council Chambers with Mayor John Mac Gillivray presiding.

The meeting opened with a prayer for Civic Authorities.

The budget was presented, discussed & adopted on a <sup>motion</sup> from Councillor Sansom seconded by Councillor Mac Naughton.

A letter was read from Dr. J. Enterprises changing his tender from \$990<sup>00</sup> for work at the dump to \$1500<sup>00</sup>. It was to inform Council that Dr. J. Enterprises had not been previously aware that the present trench had to be filled. It was moved by Councillor Sansom and seconded by Councillor

Mac Naughton that Dr. J. Enterprises be offered \$1400<sup>00</sup> for the job.

Council decided to put streetlights at Tom Murphy's, Keith Gorman's, Larry Regen's houses and another by Stanley United Church.

Council discussed what could be done about Clifford Mac Kennone dog. Black was asked to write him a letter advising him of complaints.

Meeting was adjourned on a move from Councillor Mac Naughton
