

Thursday, April 8, 1982.

Deputy Mayor Carl Mac Naughton chaired the monthly meeting of the Stanley Village Council which was held in the new Council Chamber in the Stanley Mutual Insurance Building.

The meeting opened with a prayer for civic authorities.

The minutes were read and adopted on a motion from Councillor Sansom seconded by Councillor Brittany.

Councillor Sansom reported that through the Village Engineer, Peter Forbes, that \$2400<sup>00</sup> had been collected on sewage bills & that Mr. Forbes fee was \$400<sup>00</sup>. The questions asked by Council about the work are still under investigation.

It was moved by Councillor Sansom, seconded by Councillor Brittany that the copy of the lease draft from Stanley Mutual Insurance be accepted, and that Stanley Mutual be informed of such. Carried.

Alcide Duguay is now working at the Fairhall one hour a day six days a week. Alton Bartlett is keeping track of Alcide's fee calls during the day. It was moved by Councillor Sansom that Council pay Mr. Bartlett for <sup>hour</sup> ~~day~~ six days a week @ \$7.00/hr. for the routine work that Mr. Duguay does in the fairhall. Mr. Bartlett will be compensated for fuel when Mr. Duguay makes during working hours. It was agreed that these sums will be reviewed with Mr. Bartlett in three months time. Carried.

Council decided that when the Village acquires the land where D.J. Enterprises store their equipment, other storage arrangements will have to be made.

Councillor Brittany moved & Councillor Sansom seconded the following motion: That Mr. Irving be contacted about the land his company own between Dampier's

The Library.

\* A letter was read from Harry Savage lawyer regarding a building permit for Hawaii Savings. Councilor Johnson volunteered to take the letter to Mr. Stevenson and to make arrange for a special meeting with Mr. Stevenson.

A recent sewage tank up was cleared up quickly by P. G. D. Ventres Collection Contractor.

Councilor Johnson suggested that Council might consider a yearly flush out of storm sewers by this company.

Councilor Buckley moved for adjournment.
