

Thursday, June 10, 1982.

The regular monthly meeting of the Stanley Village Council was held in the Council Chambers with Mayor John MacSullivan presiding.

The meeting opened with a prayer for Live Authorities.

Walter Dorcas, representing the Stanley Agricultural Society was there present. A letter was read from the Honorable David Bishop saying that the Village should support a plea for funds from the Agricultural Society to make improvements at the fair grounds which lie within the municipality. It was moved by Councillor Sanson & seconded by Councillor Britton that the Agricultural Society's request be met and that the clerk should write a letter to the Honorable Horace Smith so saying with carbon copies sent to Mr. Bishop and Mr. Dorcas. Carried.

The minutes were read and adopted on a motion from Councillor Britton seconded by Councillor Sanson.

Councillor Sanson reported that W. D. Enterprises and Merle & Steve Sullivan were to each put in tenders for a trench at the dump.
