

Tuesday, April 27, 1982

A special meeting of the Stanley Village Council was held in the Council Chamber in the Stanley Mutual Building with Mayor John Mac Gillivray presiding. Present at the meeting were Mr. John Stevenson - Administrator of Community Planning for the Department of Municipal Affairs & Mr. Bill Smith Development Officer for the Village of Stanley.

Mayor Mac Gillivray proposed that Council waive minutes of the last meeting and attend to the business at hand.

* A letter was read from Laurie Savage's lawyer & addressed to Councillor Mac Naughton. The letter proposed that an agreement be made between Mr. Savage and Council and Mr. Harry Savage where the Savages agreed to bring the road up to standards should any further subdivision of this property occur. (Other than Laurie Savage's house)

A discussion between Mr. Stevenson and Council ensued.

* It was moved by Councillor Sansom to offer Mr. Savage the following three options:

- ① He build the road up to standards of ^{the District} Highway Engineer.
- ② That he post a bond for \$8,000
- ③ That two surveyed building lots be turned over to the Village and when the road is built to the specifications of the District Highway Engineer the lots be given back.
