

Minutes were read and adopted, on a motion by Councillor Dord seconded by Councillor MacNaughton.

The Mayor's report was as follows: On August 2 I received word that a stimulation grant of \$5000 had been approved for 1984-85. A letter was read to Council. Peter Forbes has informed us that all delinquent sewage accounts forwarded to him to date have been passed over to the Sheriff for execution. Council is reminded that if any approaches are made to them at this stage it is appropriate to answer "it is now out of the village's hands" they must now deal with our attorney.

All things considered, I believe our programme of Aug 4 for sesquicentennial was a success. Approximately 140-150 persons on hand and much favourable comment on our choice of entertainment.

On Wednesday August 8 Norman Roy from Video Inspection Service was on hand to inspect trouble spot west of manhole near Mac Gullway's driveway. Phillip was on hand to assist. He will forward a report as well as a photo. Phillip described to me that there was a sig in the pipe 17' from the manhole, directly over a cross culvert - probably $\frac{1}{2}$ the diameter or 5" of pipe is bowed below grade and this is filled with gravel. On the spot recommendation from Roy was that it should be dug up and corrected.

Melvin has a little left to do on gravel at the library and should finish on Saturday.

Councillor Dord said that Carol Hervey had been over to look at the ditch on Garrison Ave. but nothing has been done about it. She will call Edie Butler to do the job. She also reported that the sheets were holed down by the firemen.

Mayor Smith said he'd ask D & J Construction to look after culvert & ditch problems at Elvie Fullerton's

Councillor Good mentioned pens for the Village and made the following motion: That Council proceed with the possibility of having a Village pen made up. Councillor Mac Naughton seconded the motion. Carried. Council will think about the matter and bring ideas to the next meeting with a price list if possible.

Councillor Mac Naughton said he'd had a request from Mr. Bogusch to build a rabbit farm on his property but didn't know how many rabbits would be involved. Mayor Smith thought they would be grown commercially if there was a market. Council decided to reserve a decision until more information is obtained.

Councillor Good remarked about the Gnotyph wall and topsail. Councillor Mac Naughton said that he will try to get it done soon. Councillor Mac Naughton made the motion that something in the vine line be planted to cover the wall and that in the future a flower bed should be planted. Councillor Good seconded the motion. Carried.
