Louis Douglas, Agricultural Society president has been asked again for access to spring for purposes of augmenting the Hall water supply. - no answer as yet.

Thank you to Councillor Hood for looking after the sewage problem on Monday morning Feb. 27.

The minutes were read and adopted on a motion by Councillor Hood seconded by Councillor Ross.

Councillor Ross made the motion that the Village pay for the <sup>2032</sup> signs for Neighborhood Watch. Councillor Hood seconded the motion. Carried.

The question of responsibility for sewage lines if the Ogrena plans follow through was discussed. Councillor ~~Hood~~ <sup>Ross</sup> made the motion that the subject be tabled till more information is obtained. Councillor Hood seconded the motion. Carried.

Under New Business the Job Creation Strategy was discussed. The Mayor's report contained the following outline. At a Bicenennial Meeting on Feb. 27 the Committee was anxious to have sponsored a job creation project to offer the public low cost 1984 period costumes employing four seamstresses. Cost to the Village would be in the 1000 range based on a 13 week duration. Seventy costumes should be on order for the beginning of the project. A project started April 2 and complete June 29 should make approximately 150 costumes with those who ordered responsible for supplying all materials needed. If enough costumes are not ordered the project can be interrupted or terminated.

Clerk was asked to order 2 copies of the Municipal Act & 2 copies of the Community Planning Act.

Councillor Ross had had a complaint from June Sparks about the bad condition on Water Street and he assured her that Council would do something this spring.

Councillor Wood had a drawing from Doug showing what would be done at the library. She also had the people

Councillor Wood reported on a Directors Meeting at the Villa. They are to have a new lease and consideration by the board drawn up by a lawyer. It is to be presented to Dr. Wagner who will have ten days to review it before signing. A new doctor Dr. How is to arrive on July 1. Agnes gave an excellent report. She said that there are 33 people on a waiting list for beds at the Villa. Mr. Wiper resigned from the board & Bill Mac Donald took his place. The Ambulance Brigade would like to store its emergency supplies on the Fire Hall. Councillor Ross will look after this. Mess on Wheels has thirty names but hasn't started yet.

Councillor Ross moved for adjournment.
