

Thursday, April 11, 1985

There was a meeting of the Stanley Village Council held in the Council Chambers with Mayor J. William Smith in the chair.

The meeting opened with a prayer for Civic Authorities.

March 14 minutes were read and approved on a motion from Councillor Hood seconded by Councillor Ross.

Mayor's Report

Angus was asked by a member of the Dept. of Municipal Affairs to sit on a regional assessment review board and has accepted.

Sheila Wagner is locally in charge of securing funds for the buscan at D.E.C.

The Mayor had had a visit from Yves Desautels who has taken Ray Guthrie's ^{old job} place in the R.C.M.P.

Phillip missed ^{the} required course in March because of a death in the family.

Mayor Smith read a report about the work that has been done so far by the Fredericton Solid Waste Disposal Commission.

A letter from W.H. Lundell and Associates was read. Clerk was asked to write back & ask for a review of each property in detail.

Councillor Ross said the plan is still waiting for work to be done on it.

Councillor Hood had a letter concerning pens for the Village. Councillor Ross made the motion that Judy Bartlett be asked to design a Village pen and Council is prepared to pay up to \$50 if she comes up with an acceptable design. Councillor Mac Naughton seconded the motion. Carried. Council would prefer a design that is in some way historical to Stanley.

Minutes of April 4 were read and accepted on a motion from Councillor Ross seconded by Councillor Hood.

"the building must be 20 ft. from the back slope of the ditch" and noting that Village and Provincial regulations call for 55 ft. from the center of the road. Motion carried. Council decided that one building permit should cover the entire Aguna construction and whatever it entails.

Councillor Hood made the motion that the building permit fee should be \$100 instead of \$450⁰⁰ which the Village could otherwise expect. Councillor MacNaughton seconded the motion. Carried.

The Village holds the deed for the present unk. property which the Aguna Committee wants for a parking lot on a long term lease. There was some discussion about the words "long term" Councillor Hood made the motion, seconded by Councillor Ross that Council is considering a lease on the unk ground with details to be worked out, as soon as possible.

Councillor Hood mentioned Mr. Wades water hole and Mayor Smith said he'd get Chelip to investigate the matter.

Councillor Hood was asked to get Wayne Cleveland to dig a ditch along Harrison Ave. and to sweep the sidewalks.

Councillor Ross said that he'd talk to Alvin about a permanent garbage container at the Cenotaph.

Parking problems were discussed. Coun. MacNaughton moved, seconded by Coun. Hood that Council get in touch with the Highway Patrol to request that any member of their force issue warning for parking violators in the Village until May 15 and after that charge all offenders. Motion carried.

Councillor Ross moved for adjournment.
