Mayor's Report

Chop sealing for Silva Lane (approx \$6000) and Water St. (approx \$4000) will definitely be done this summer. It is expected that 1985 Stimulation Grants will be cancelled.

The last Bi-Cent. Meeting was held June 10. There was over \$1800⁰⁰ left over. The Comm. intended to give the money to the Multiple Sclerosis Fund but Neta didn't want it so the balance was given to the Museum Fund.
