

Thursday March 14, 1985

There was a meeting held in the Council Chambers of the Stanley Village Council with Mayor J. William Smith presiding.

The meeting opened with a prayer for Civic Authorities.

The minutes were read, corrected and adopted on a motion from Councillor Ross seconded by Councillor Ford.

Mr. John Stevenson administrator of Community Planning for the Dept. of Municipal Affairs was present.

Mayor Smith explained to Council that he had been talking to Terry Youngblood about garbage disposal. Terry sent him information about plans that the Fredericton Solid Waste Disposal Commission had to include all communities within a 25 mile radius and this would include Stanley. Mayor Smith suggested that Council put a hold on land purchase until a study is made of this plan. The Department of Environment is about to pass a law to prohibit burning of garbage so a very large amount of land would be required.

Mr. Stevenson then answered questions about easements, animals in municipalities, snow removal, municipal plan and zoning By-law review, the Agona building permit, (section 35(a) and (b) would cover it) and Unseemly Premises. Mayor Smith thanked Mr. Stevenson for his attendance.

Mayor Smith told Council that Murray Thomas got hold of one of the culprits snow melting on his property and the situation is alleviated.

Phillip will take a course requested by the Dept.

A letter was read from D. Leticia Forbes.

Councillor Ross made the following motion: That Council give permission to Village solicitor, D. Leticia Forbes, to proceed through the Sheriff for seizure and sale of properties when it becomes necessary through due process because of unpaid sewage fees. Councillor Mac Naughton seconded the motion. Carried.

Councillor Ford was appointed to actively pursue the quest for pens for the Village.

Councillor Ford made the motion that a special meeting of Council be held April 4 for discussion of wages and job description. Councillor Ross seconded the motion. Carried.

Councillor Ross made the motion that April 24 be set aside for Council to hold a meeting to review the Municipal Plan and Zoning By-law. Councillor Ford seconded the motion. Carried.

Eleanore Sparkes is having water problems because of a peulvert. Council decided that it was the responsibility of the Dept. of Education.

It was moved by Councillor Ford and seconded by Councillor Ross that Council grant up to \$200 to the mixed Junior Curling Team toward expenses for the Provincials in Sackville. Carried. May vote by Councillor Mac Naughton recorded.

Councillor Ross reported that the vehicle for the firm is on hand and lesioned. Art born repaired to broken water pump. Councillor Ross will negotiate with hosts about pay for clearing the library. Village Council admit responsibility for this expense.

Councillor Ford reported that Dr. Wagner lease has been renewed until the end of April in order to complete Photo Copying. Made on Wheels have 21 recipients. A new fish tank for the Hall has been purchased with funds from the hono. Dr. Wagner. A letter from Mr. Fomroy was read asking for a person in the area to assist in fund raising for a CAT scanner for D.E.C.H. Mayor Smith will take care of it. Councillor Ford moved adjournment.
