

The minutes were read, corrected, and passed, on a motion from Councillor Ross seconded by Councillor MacNaughton.

Mayor Smith said the street signs are ready, and Mr. F. and he will see that they get to Stanley's and put in place.

No. Wood has come back from the Dept. of Environment about the lagoon.

Councillor Hood reported that the Villa Board would be delighted to have seven 22" x 32" pictures from the Bicentennial Calendar. She will try to get the original scraps & then Mayor Smith will look after it.

Councillor Hood took the letter from C. G. W. B. to the Institute and Agnes Sellick is filling it in, and would be happy.

Councillor MacNaughton would like a Dept. of the Envir. representative to look at the old dump site which is in Stanley.

After being told that he would have to have his property subdivided and that he could not put a trailer on it, Walter Sellick decided against moving the bungalow house and put his trailer on Grants Glen Road. Since it was within Village limits he bought the required permit.

There followed a discussion regarding types of houses in different neighborhoods in the Village. A by-law regarding this subject was tabled for future study.

Sub-division plans for Esau's property were examined by Council.

Mayor Smith had had enquiries from Mrs. Lawrence Blakney of P. E. I. about what is required by the village to build a house. Clerk was asked to write to her.

Annual reports from N. B. E. P. E., the Ombudsmen, and the Department of Transportation were examined, as well as a Communiqué from the Premier's Office about the disabled.

Councillor Ross said the Village is responsible for the history building, and York Regional for the books, so no further insurance is necessary.

Letter was read from Henry H. Clark regarding Municipal Insurance.

Councillor Cross reported that the van would be done by the end of October and the water system for the fire hall will be worked on right away. Councillor Cross made the motion that Dieter be reinstated to Fire Chief vs. Melvon and that Melvon be ^{instated} reappointed to Deputy Fire Chief vs. Dieter by mutual desire of both parties effective date Oct 1, 1985. Carried. MacNaughton 2nd Carried.

Councillor Hood attended a meeting of the Villa Board and mentioned among other things that the ambulance fund drive had netted \$5658.00 and that, for the first time, the Accreditation Certificate is for three years.

Council liked Judge drawings for a Village sign.

Councillor Hood reported that Village signs had been ordered from Jeff Smith.

Dieter should be here by the end of the month. Councillor MacNaughton will look after the planting.

Councillor Cross made the motion that the clerk write to the R.C.M.P. and the Highway Patrol thanking them for maintaining order not only around the Stanley Fair but in the Village as well. Councillor Hood seconded the motion ^(Carried). Councillor Hood moved for adjournment.
