

Thursday, March 13, 1986

There was a meeting held in the Council Chamber of the Stanley Village Council with Mayor J. Wm Smith in the chair.

The meeting opened with a prayer for Civic Authorities. The minutes were read, corrected & approved on a motion from Councillor Hood seconded by Coun. MacNaughton.

Mayor Smith reported on the pictures for the Village. It was more expedient to have them done in different sizes, but they were well received.

Mayor Smith had met with Dale Mac Fulture and has the survey for two railway properties. Dale advised that deeds should be made up before registration of the plan of survey. Dale also wants a letter from the village with authorization to serve the village interest in surveying matters.

A letter was read from the Department of Municipal Affairs explaining the proposed unconditional grant base. Tuesday March 18 there will be a Regional meeting for Zone 3 in Fredericton City. There at 7 p.m. Council plans to attend. The Mayor will be unable to go so had a written report on his thoughts on the subject. Coun.

Ross made the motion that Mayor Smith should write a letter on the subject and it should be sent to the Minister of Municipal Affairs and Environment with a copy sent to Hon. H. Blane. If possible the letter should be read at the March 19 meeting. Councillor Hood seconded the motion. Carried.

A report on a plan of action for Youth was mentioned by the Mayor.

A letter from the Town's Council for disabled people regarding parking pass in designated parking zones was read.

Councillor God reported that Village order for signs and pass had been received and would be shipped on March 21. Total cost \$1460.00.

Annual report of the Department of Municipal Affairs was passed around the table.

Letter and Mayor's reply to it was read. The letter suggested that the words City of, Town of and Village of be eliminated in front of Municipality names.

Mr Weeks is retiring as Presbyterian minister the end of March. Council will make him an honorary citizen of Stanley and Judy Bartlett is making him a suitable scroll. Councillor Liu made the motion that Council also give him a suitable gift. Councillor Mac Naughton seconded the motion. Carried.

Councillor God reported that Mary Shields is the new Director of Nursing at the Vels. She started work March 12, 1986. A retirement party for Cygnis is being planned.

Councillor Mac Naughton moved for adjournment.
