

* Mayor apologized to Dougie on behalf of Council

Monday, November 17, 1986

There was a meeting of the Stanley Village Council held in the Council Chambers with Mayor J. Wm. Smith in the chair.

The meeting opened with a prayer for Civic Authorities.

The minutes were read, corrected and adopted on a motion by Councillor Bogisch seconded by Councillor Mac Naughton.

There was a discussion about what type of material was to be put on the bulletin board. Council decided that it would be up to the discretion of Council and not be for advertising and for sale ads, items of general interest to the community.

The Mayor and Councillor Bogisch met with Sgt. Fleiger and a member of the N.B.H.P. interested in putting a home on the Bruce Douce site in Kirkton but so far Bruce Douce has been unavailable. The R.C.M.P. had not contacted Council again about the matter.

Terry's restaurant has a very serious noise problem. Councillor Bogisch made the motion, seconded by Councillor Wood that a letter to Terry regarding this matter should be written. Mayor Smith will write it.

There was an itemized list from Do J Enterprise with work done for the Stimulation Grant.

A letter of complaint from Doug Mac Donell was read. Tender for dump trenching called for 450 ft long & actual length was 300 ft. *

An estimate from Grandall and Associates for sewage expansion was \$325 000⁰⁰ based on vacuum pump usage. Mayor Smith had talked to

Mayor Smith reported that community support was good at a recent public meeting regarding school expansion. The school board accepted the proposal and it has been forwarded to the Department of Education.

Dr. J. Enterprises tender for winter snow removal was read. A motion from February 1986 regarding snow removal was read. A committee was to have been set up this summer on a complete job description for tenders. Councillor Wood made the motion that the February motion be held in abeyance for this season and that Dr. J. Enterprises tender be accepted at \$4500. Councillor Bogard seconded the motion. Carried.

Letter from school asking for money to help send two students to the Terry Fox Centre in Ottawa. Councillor Bogard made the motion that the Village donate \$4000. Councillor MacNaughton seconded the motion. Carried.

Letter from Association of Villages with a zoning change for Villages in the area.

A letter from Wilson's Insurance was read regarding liability insurance.

A letter from Health Centre regarding volunteers was read. It will be posted on the Bulletin Board.

Councillor Wood made the motion, seconded by Councillor MacNaughton that Village pay \$135 that remains on a
