10	Smith	<u>Storm Sewers</u> - Councillor MacNaughton viewed the situation and concentrated on the problem. He reported that it is not really our problem, but is that of Mr. Johnstone himself. After much discussion, Council agreed, by general agreement, that the best solution at this time seemed to be for the Agrena Association and Mr. Johnstone to get together and get permission from adjacent landowner's to try and correct the problem via a back-yard route, rather than directing the problem towards the street.	n/a



- 11 Smith Anglican Church Hall - Village Council now have clear title to this property and, as of today, have the Deed in our possession. Mayor Smith has spoken to Mr. Wayne Cleveland about the possibility of him tearing down the building. n/a
- 12 Smith N.B. Highway Patrol (Police Service) - Councillor Bogisch spoke with Sgt. Marche who expressed his thanks to Council for their co-operation over the past years. Councillor Bogisch suggested that Council send Sgt. Marche a letter of thanks for his services over the years, and Mr. Bogisch agreed to write the letter. He also reported that the Breathalyzer Unit will remain in Village Office until the RCMP officially take over; contract with RCMP has not been signed as yet. B.G.B.
- 13 Smith Letter From Mary O'Hara - Councillor MacNaughton has been unable to make contact with Roy O'Hara. He is going to try to see him on Saturday, August 13/88. He has been in contact with Martin Fullarton. He reported that the problem was not present until the new Storm Sewer System was installed. Councillor MacNaughton will try and get Mr. O'Hara and Mr. Fullarton together on this matter. E.MacN.
- 14 Smith Supply & Services Property (Irishtown Road) - Deeds now received for this property. n/a
- 15 Smith CN Property - Follow-Up - Council Members received a copy of the letter that had been sent to landowner's of former CN Property on the Glen Road. Mayor Smith reported that he had visited Mr. Peter Forbes yesterday (August 10/88) and Mr. Forbes reported that he had been in contact with Mr. George McCoy's Solicitor, Mr. Ronald Ashfield. Mr. Ashfield commented that he had searched and searched the property of Mrs. Elsie Reid and was unable to find anything concerning the CNR Right-Of-Way, but stated that he is going to advise his clients to pay our price NOW and get this situation settled. Council decided to sit tight on this situation in the Glen Road area. n/a
- 16 Bogisch Introduction of Draft Amendment - By-Law #20 - Mayor Smith and Councillor Bogisch did meet on July 29/88 to discuss same. They contacted other Municipalities and also contacted Mr. David Ellis, who responded with helpful information. Councillor Bogisch had circulated copies of other Village Sewage Structure Breakdowns and went over them with Council.
MOTION: That Councillor Bogisch again review our Draft Amendment, and upon completion, circulate to Council before next Council Meeting, and later display a letter on Village Bulletin Board informing residents of the review and possible increase in the near future. - 17 Smith Pumping Stations - Mayor reported that the light came on in one of the Sewage Pumps, and as Phillip Campbell was away, Mr. Stan Foreman was called to repair it. Mayor stated that both Pumping Stations should be painted, and instructed Clerk to call Phillip Campbell and ask him to do it as soon as possible. Clerk

- 18 Smith Culverts - both culverts requested by Peggy Anderson have now been installed by Mr. Pat Flynn. Mayor advised Mrs. Anderson that he couldn't give her a price, but that she would be billed for the extra costs for work over the standards. Mayor and Pat Flynn also viewed together the Allan Gullison situation. n/a
- 19 Smith Video - Local Government - has now been received and Clerk instructed to contact Blackville and Doaktown and advise that we now have it in our possession, and ask them for dates that they would like to have it. Clerk
- 20 Smith Building Inspector - Angus Sansom and Mayor Smith had visited Mr. Peter Forbes and had discussed the price of Building Permits. It was discussed that the amount of work involved was far above the price of \$5.00, which we are now charging. Clerk was instructed to send Peter Forbes excerpts from the By-Law concerning same, so that it would give him an idea as to how things were set up. Clerk
- 21 Hood Fallen Tree at Corner By McWade's - was caused by the Wind and Thunderstorm on August 4, 1988. She complained that it was a hazard to cars passing on the street, as branches were expanding on to the road. She would like to have it cleaned up as soon as possible. Mayor spoke with Mr. Mark Foreman, who will do the job in the near future. n/a
- 22 Hood Stanley Fair Donation

- 23 Smith Request From Mary Hay - Mayor read her letter requesting new culvert, because of water problem in basement. Mayor commented that the problem is present because there was never a floor drain installed in the basement. It was agreed that there is nothing that Village can do for her, and Mayor Smith agreed to contact her. Smith
- 24 Pirmock Request for Holiday in September - for the 2 week period September 22 - October 5/88. (Two Monday's and Two Thursday's). She also asked if she could work the afternoon of SEPTEMBER 1/88 (THURSDAY) instead of the morning.
