- 12 Smith Letter From Mary O'Hara - Councillor MacNaughton was absent from Council Meeting, but received verbal report from him on October 17, 1988 stating that he had spoken with Pat Flynn re this problem, and Mr. Flynn said that he would look after it. He has not heard back from him concerning such. E.McN.
- 13 Smith CN Property - Mayor stated that Mr. Melvin Bartlett's name had been omitted from the list. Clerk to add his name to the list and send him a copy of the letter that was sent out. Clerk
- 14 Bogisch Introduction of Draft Amendment - Sewage By-Law - Councillor Bogisch read the Draft Notice that he had prepared to be posted on Bulletin Board advising citizens of changes in Sewage Rates. Clerk instructed to send letters to Mr. Douglas MacDonald and Mr. Patrick Flynn, attaching the job description, adding to the area, to also include the parking lot that is extended north of the Post Office. Replies to be received no later than NOON, October 25, 1988. (TUESDAY).
- 24 Smith Request From Hazel Coughlan - Mayor read her request that Mrs. Maggie Clarkson's driveway be repaired as the curb is broken up, making the access to her driveway very bumpy. Clerk instructed to contact Walter Dorcas at Dept. of Transportation re same. Clerk
- 25 Smith Letter From Capital Region Development Com. - advising of a Trade Show to be held November 2 and 3, 1988, at Hotel Beausejour in Moncton (Small Business Week.) n/a
- 26 Smith Letter From Jennifer Griffiths - Environmental Protection Branch - Clerk instructed to write a letter to Mr. James Knight of this Branch for guidelines in including some provisions in our Zoning By-Law regarding the control and location of certain industries, and asking him if he could supply us with a copy. Clerk
- 27 Smith Dexter Chaffey (Stanley Fire Department) - Mr. Chaffey attended meeting and presented to Council the necessity of new 2-way Radio System for the Fire Department. He advised that he had visited with the Fire Dept. in Keswick and viewed their Radio System.
