4	Forbes	<u>Property - C. Humby, H.J. McAloon, Allan Gullison</u> - Clerk reported that Dale MacFarlane had been in contact with her concerning same. DMcF	
5	Smith	<u>Fire Department</u> - Mayor Smith advised Council of a Training Seminar available for Firemen at a cost of \$100/ fireman. Mr. Dexter Chaffey asked if Council could expend funds for this effort. It would involve two Saturdays and 4 or 5 evenings of their time. The number of those attending would not be more than 6 from our department. By general agreement, Council decided to cover the cost of this seminar for the Fire Dept.	n/a

- 9 Johnstone Emergency Response Numbers - Councillor Johnstone stated that there is nothing further to report at this time. n/a
- 10 Hood Snow Removal - Mayor Smith advised that D & J Entp. was the successful bidder, as the work done previous to date of bid was covered in the quoted price. n/a
- 11 Hood Stanley Post Cards - nothing further at this time. n/a
- 12 Smith Library Letter - Mayor Smith advised that he had sent this letter, a copy of which was circulated to Council. n/a
- 13 Smith Anticipated Purchase of Property - Cecil Pond - Clerk reported that a cheque had been sent to Peter Forbes In Trust to cover the cost of the property, and Mr. Forbes had been to see Mr. Pond for his signature on the Deed, but a few minor changes had to be made, which delayed the signing. P.Forbes
- 14 Johnstone Computer - Clerk asked permission to purchase the MAS Support Line at a cost of \$50 per month. MOTION: Council agreed that we purchase the MAS Support Program for a period of one year and re-evaluate at that time. CLERK
- 15 Hood Christmas Tree Lighting Celebration - Councillor Hood reported that she had attended this event and said a few words on behalf of Council. She reported on a very poor attendance, made up mostly of students, and that they enjoyed hot chocolate and hot apple cider and held a carol sing-song. She stated that the planning had been left too late, and asked if Council might organize this event next year. Councillor Johnstone suggested that next year we set a date of October 15/90 to commence planning and organizing this event, with which Council agreed. n/a
- 16 Johnstone Parking At Cornish Corner - Councillor Johnstone reported that he had not been very successful in contacting Peter Forbes, but hopes to make progress shortly. LJ
- 17 Hood Christmas Tree Bonfire - Mayor Smith reported that there were twice as many trees as last year, an estimate of 50 to 60 people attended. Suggestions for next year were that we have some music, and possibly serve the trays of refreshments outside. n/a

- 18 Johnstone Prizes - Library - he advised that Mrs. Dunphy stated that they would be doing something in Feb. or March. n/a
- 19 Smith Letter - United Nations Association in Canada - the name of Mrs. Pearl Boyce from Williamsburg was agreed on by Council. Clerk to gather information and submit it by January 31, 1990. CLERK
- 20 Smith Chain of Office - Clerk advised that she had been in contact with Aitkens Pewter of 170 Urquhart Cr. Fredericton, NB and received an estimated cost of \$500 for same. This would have Maple Leaf symbols on it, a velvet collar, the NB emblem, and Village Crest at the bottom. Clerk asked to obtain some brochures and visible information on same. CLERK
- 21 Smith Letter - Way To Go New Brunswick - in which they asked that any comments be received by Feb.16/90. Booklet to be reviewed by Council and information to be brought back to next Council Meeting. COUNCIL
- 22 Smith Renewal - Miramichi Headwaters - agreed to renew. MOTION: Council agreed to renew at a cost of \$27.50 per year. MOTION: F. Hood / L. Johnstone
- 23 Smith Map - Municipal Kilometrage - asking that we insert names of highways and various buildings in Village. This was done and is ready to be returned to them. n/a
- 24 Smith Letter - Crown Life Participaction - to be held on May 30, 1990. Council decided to maintain this on our Agenda for next few months. CLERK
- 25 Smith Letter - NB Tel - Radio System - a copy of which was circulated to Council. Mayor Smith reported that David Gourley had contacted Clerk to advise that the tower has reserved full capacity, and that his alternative advice would be a tower site in Ward Settlement which might be obtained from Department of Transportation, if we requested, and he also commented that he thought it would be a much better site. Mayor Smith reported that he had contacted a Mr. John Palmer of Transportation & Communications who advised him to contact Mr. Glen Trail. Mayor Smith contacted Mr. Trail by letter, a copy of which was circulated to Council. Mayor Smith reported to Council that we may acquire this property for nothing. Estimate cost of pole and installation, etc. would be \$1,500.00. The building that is already

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at this site may not be in suitable condition. The maintenance costs would be considerably low as all that is required is proper ventilation for winter and a light bulb. DOT forms not to be returned until the site is determined. DOT

- 26 Smith Letter - Capital Region Crime Stoppers - letter was circulated to Council. n/a
- 27 Smith Memo - Capital Region Development Comm. - advising of a Student Employment Programme sponsored by Dept. of Labour for the summer of 1990. C. Johnstone requested that we inquire ahead of time and obtain information about the details of the Programme, and also asked that Council think about what work we would have for them to do. Clerk asked to obtain some sort of information package concerning same. CLERK
- 28 Smith Letter - Hubert Seamans - Mun. Affairs - concerning access to public buildings for disabled persons, a copy of which was circulated to Council. FILE
- 29 Smith Invoice - D & J Enterprises Ltd. - billing us for the hauling of debris to dump from the Anglican Church Hall site, which was approved for payment. CLERK
- 30 Smith Letter - Town of Sackville - which was circulated to Council. Clerk instructed to file under Promotional Programmes. CLERK
- 31 Smith Letter - SMA Engineering - offering of services. Letter to be filed. CLERK
- 32 Smith Invoice - Peter Forbes - for services rendered to end of year. n/a
- 33 Smith Thank-You Cards - from Eric Foreman and Wendy Dorcas for the Village Pins given to them when they visited The Terry Fox Centre in Ottawa. n/a
- 34 Smith Debris - EMPTY BOXES - On Highways & Streets And In Ditches - Councillor MacNaughton received this complaint from Joseph Thibeault who reported that he is tired of picking up same. It seems that it must be falling from someone's truck, but until we know who for sure, we cannot send a letter. n/a
- 35 Clerk Request for Purchase of Large Garbage Disposal Unit she reported that with the computer, there is much more paper to be disposed of, and asked if she could

purchase same. She asked Councillor Hood if she would ask her husband, Douglas Hood, if he would be able to construct a unit similar to those that he built for Stanley Mutual Insurance Co. F.HOOD
