MINUTES

- 1 MARK COMEAU - NBEPCC -- made a presentation to Council of what he was offering as assistance toward our River Walkway. He advised Council of free labour costs and machinery rental costs, etc. that would be provided by them. He stated that this assistance would probably not be available until next year (spring) and, as yet, is still tentative. Council agreed that perhaps we should hold off on doing the Walkway ourselves if this assistance is available. We will await more information from Mr. Comeau.

- 2 MARK FOREMAN - FIRE CHIEF--advised of a meeting to be held on July 29, 1992 at 7:30 p.m. at which he would like to see Mr. Rob Costelo attend. He stated that the Fire Dept. have commenced work towards the Civic Numbering in the Village Limits, but need more maps for outside areas.

- 3 R.C.M.P. REPRESENTATIVE -- reported on happenings in the area over the past month including cottage break-ins and motor vehicle warnings, etc. Mayor Ross reported to him of recent damage at Stanley High School, and also urged that we need more speed signs, especially on Stanley Hill.

- 4 APPROVAL OF PREPARED AGENDA:

- 5 APPROVAL OF PRE-CIRCULATED MINUTES OF JUNE 11, 1992 AND JUNE 25, 1992  
MOTION: B. MACDONALD \ E. MACNAUGHTON CARRIED.

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- 6 DANIEL GLENN LTD. -- COMMUNITY IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM -- tenders were received for the paving project, and Council agreed that GORMAN PAVING was the successful bidder with a price of \$4,494.00 including GST. Mayor Ross will advise all bidders of the outcome, and will contact Mrs. Eva Bennett to request her approval of having the area that is owned by her paved where the potholes are so numerous. He will also ask Gorman Paving to do an additional piece of paving from manhole to Fire Hall.  
MOTION: That Gorman Paving be the successful bidder at a price of \$4,494.00 including GST and that Mayor Ross contact Mrs. Eva Bennett for approval of paving the area that is now potholes which is owned by her and to ask Gorman Paving for an extra piece of paving from manhole to Fire Hall.

MOTION: It was moved that when the paving is completed, Village have all the painting for parking done at one time, and that the first space nearest the Bank be for paraplegic.

- 7 COMMUNITY BASED POLICING COMMITTEE -- Councillor Freda Hood was not present at meeting, so we had no report at this time.

- 8 PURCHASE OF OFFICE BUILDING FROM STANLEY MUTUAL INSURANCE COMPANY-- Clerk reported that she had spoken with Paul Inman today and he stated that our application has been approved, but has to have the Order In Council which is approval by the Lieutenant-Governor, and that this will probably take 2 - 3 months. He suggested that as soon as we obtain the Order In Council, that we get a Bank Loan for a year in order to stabilize our increase in Tax Rate for next year. He also advised for us to go ahead with any plans that we had.  
Clerk also advised that Mr. Reginald Davis was over to look at the building to see if possible apartments could be installed. He stated that he needed someone to help him measure the rooms, etc. Mayor Ross agreed to contact Mr. Davis to complete same.

- 9 STANLEY GROUP COMMITTEE -- Councillor MacNaughton advised that the next meeting is scheduled for August 11, 1992.

- 10 NASHWAAK VILLA BOARD -- Councillor MacNaughton advised that the Annual Meeting was held on June 23, 1992.

- 11 EMERGENCY RESPONSE NUMBERS -- Fire Department meeting scheduled for Wednesday Night, July 29, 1992. Councillor Barbara MacDonald will represent Council at this meeting.

- 12 RESULTS OF SPECIAL MEETING - SEWAGE USER RATES -- Clerk presented Financial Statement for Sewage Account to Council and urged them of the importance of necessary improvements to this financial situation. After much discussion, Council agreed that Clerk would draft a letter to Sewage Users to be approved and amended by Council.  
MOTION: It was moved that Clerk draft a letter to Sewage Users for Council to consider advising of the situation of the Sewerage System and of the intention of increasing rates by 50% (\$20 Per Quarter). MOTION: B. MACDONALD \ E. MACNAUGHTON CARRIED.

- 13 JETSTREAM PROGRAM -- Council are aware of no problems with this program at present. Clerk advised Council that two students with Athletics N.B. have been working with the children in the area of Track and Field for the past two weeks at no expense to us.  
Councillor Barb MacDonald reported that she had received numerous comments on the addition of flowers to the Village.

- 14 SEIZURE OF DOGS -- Council decided, by general agreement, that Dog Catcher has to contact Council first, before he acts on any complaints from citizens to seize dogs.
