COMMUNITY IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM

Mayor Ross advised Council that there will be a Public Meeting on October 15, 1992 at the Upper Nashwaak Agrena Association concerning The Constitution. All Council Members are urged to attend.

Councillors Freda Hood and Barbara MacDonald were back to the old Park and took inventory of the playground equipment still in tact. There seems to be a roundabout, swings, slide, teeter-totter and swinging horses. If they were painted, they would make a great start.

Mayor Ross reported that Devon Lumber seem to be the only company that sells round fencing with 5' posts, and they will deliver in two to three weeks. Prices are as follows: 10' rails - \$5.95 Cedar, \$5.65 Spruce: 8' rails - \$4.40 Cedar, but would require extra posts.

Lighting was discussed. Agreed that we would need possibly two streetlights in the area.

It was agreed that we require 4 Picnic Tables, 8' Long (2 with Canopies), 6 Park Benches and 6 Trash Receptacles. An archway was discussed for the entrance.

Mayor Ross and Councillor MacNaughton will draw up Tenders for the Picnic Tables, Benches and Trash Receptacles. Mayor Ross will also order post and railings; Councillors Hood and MacDonald will keep investigating prices for playground equipment.



Councillor Earle MacNaughton will represent Council at the Public Meeting on October 15, 1992 regarding The Constitution.
