6 **POLICING COMMITTEE MEETING**

Councillor Freda Hood gave her monthly report on this committee. She advised that Crime Stoppers visited the School on June 9th and June 11th; well received by teachers and students. She also reported that SHS and RCMP Rep's challenged each other in a Volleyball Game on June 2nd/93. She reported on the Ident-A-Child held on June 12th/93 with approximately 25 children in attendance. The committee was not pleased with the manner in which the RCMP Rep's left the Stanley Mutual Building. Jennifer Dysart reported to the Committee on Recreation for young people and some of the different ideas that she had. Rhonda Calhoun reported to the committee on a meeting that she attended at the School on June 10th/93 where a great number of parents volunteered to help out in different Programs, Computer, Drama Club, etc. Mrs. Hood stated that TADD (Teen's Against Drunk Drivers) is to be held in the fall. The next meeting is scheduled for September 28, 1993.
