

SPECIAL MEETING OF STANLEY VILLAGE COUNCIL

NOVEMBER 22, 1993

Ms. MacKay advised that approximately \$22,000 was being spent for shelving, and also that cataloguing of books is well under way now. She is hoping that the move will take place in January, but it depends on when the shelving arrives.

Sara Dunton asked if an announcement could be made concerning the new Community Library at the official opening of the new Stanley School to be held on Wednesday Evening, December 1, 1993. She also stated that the issue of the Sign for the Library should be agreed upon between the Village and District #18, and as to who is responsible for the costs, etc. She suggested that Council initiate this project and contact Wayne Tingley or Dr. Miller.

Ian MacBean inquired as to whether or not the money that was budgeted for these months that the library has not been in the school could be used for extra staffing, etc. Ms. MacKay stated that, if it is accessible, it could be used for Project Workers.

Ms. MacKay advised that the library should only be closed for one week when the move takes place. No furniture has arrived as yet.

All present agreed that a delivery date of shelving be obtained, and if it is a possibility that it won't be delivered until March 1994, they would like to go ahead with other arrangements in order to move.

Mayor Ross signed this Agreement, and it was witnessed by the Village clerk.

At this time, the visitors at this meeting departed.

Clerk introduced a letter from Council asking for contribution toward the Senior Citizen's Party to be held on December 4, 1993. Council agreed to donate \$50.00 toward this event.
