1 PRAYER FOR CIVIC AUTHORITIES

2 RCMP REPRESENTATIVE

Staff Sgt. Ouellette was present and explained to Council the newly proposed division of districts and territory, etc. within their organization, with the Province of New Brunswick being divided into 10 districts with Tracadie as the hub. Fredericton will be District #2 which hinges on Oromocto building a new office (possibly by the spring of '97). Some locations will close including Newcastle, and the Bathurst City Police Dept. will be expanding.

He explained that Burt's Corner is a proposed area for District Policing, perhaps even possibly Harvey. He urged Stanley Village Council to exert pressure if interested in accommodating same. He stated that the reasoning for choosing Burt's Corner would be mostly geographical. He stressed to council that they should first find out what District Policing is all about, and then suggest that we would be interested in having it in Stanley, also asking why there is a proposed detachment for Burt's Corner. He suggested a contact, Jerry Sanford, Planning Section, and stated that they would probably be prepared to make a presentation to us by September.

He presented their monthly report for July, and asked if the squealing of tires, etc. had diminished at all. He advised Council that they have a Motor Home which will be available for the entire week-end of the Stanley Fair which will house 3 members at that time, hoping that this will lessen any unlawful actions during this time. Clerk is to obtain a schedule of events of the Stanley Fair and fax it to him.
