13 COMMUNITY IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM

Mayor Ross advised Council that Wilfred Ryan gave a price of \$350 for cutting the bushes on the walking trail and \$500 with a skidder. David Merrill also gave a price, being \$500 without a machine. Mayor Ross commented that Wilfred Ryan has already begun the work. It was decided and agreed that, in order to complete the walking trail and other work desired within the park before the end of the year, we needed: crusher dust, 2 park benches, 2 trash

receptacles, footbridge material and labour, labour for cutting the bushes along the trail, loads of fill, bulldozing and compaction, potholes and posts with reflector tape, and landscaping of shrubs, stone, treated wood at the Park.

23 CHUB & DIANE MACKINNON - SEWAGE



Council agreed that The MacKinnon's be billed the same as Terry's Restaurant, commencing in January of 1995, at \$120.00\Quarter for 2 Units.
