It was advised that it is now a Municipal Mandatory Regulation that each and every Municipality in the Province of New Brunswick have a By-Law enacted to stipulate the organization of a Disaster Plan for each individual area.

Ms. Malone advised that there would be 35 residents from the Villa to have evacuated, and the entire group discussed possible places within the area that would allow and accommodate this number of people.

It was agreed that we should contact other organizations such as Red Cross, Government Departments, Search & Rescue, etc., and also that it would be wise to have an accurate up-to-date Resource List. Clerk will try to obtain copies of By-Laws and Disaster Plans from other Villages who are comparable to us in size and available resources.

After much discussion, Council decided that the first step we have to take is to get our By-Law enacted, and then form a committee with representatives from various organizations, and once we have other plans to review, try to compose our own plan, while intermingling various sections and points of all the others.

The next meeting for this project is planned for Monday Afternoon, July 25, 1994 at Stanley Village Office at 1:00 PM, thus allowing Clerk time to gather up some of this necessary information.

OTHER BUSINESS

As our Development Officer, Angus Sansom, is away for the summer, Council agreed to appoint an acting body in his absence.
